- 4. List of polluted areas, by type of pollutant & location
- 5. Info. on use & conservation of natural resources & ecosystem services
- 6. Scientific, technical or technological reports, studies & info. on env. matters
- 7. Climate change sources aimed at building national capacities
- 8. Info. on EIA processes, env. management instruments & env. licences or permits
- 9. Estimated list of waste by type, volume, location & year
- 10. Info. on administrative sanctions imposed in env. matters

## PARTICIPATE IN WHAT?



- Projects & activities with significant impact on env.
- Land-use planning, policies, strategies, plans, programmes, rules & regulations with significant impact on env.
- International forums & negotiations

### EARLY NOTIFICATION AND PROVISION OF INFORMATION

- Type or nature of decision in non-technical language
- Authority making decision & authorities involved
- Participation procedure (timeline & opportunities)
- Date and place for public consultation or hearing



## EARLY NOTIFICATION AND PROVISION OF INFORMATION

# ACCESS TO JUSTICE

Article 8

#### TYPES OF CHALLENGES



#### **Decisions, actions or omissions:**

- Access to environmental information
- Public participation in decision-making process regarding environmental matters
- Adverse effects on the environment or violation of environmental laws & regulations

### **OBGLIATIONS TO ENSURE ACCESS TO JUSTICE**

- State entities with access to expertise in env. matters
- Effective, timely, public, transparent & impartial procedures that are **not prohibitively expensive**
- Broad active legal standing in defence of the environment
- Possibility of precautionary & interim measures to prevent, halt, mitigate or rehabilitate damage to the environment
- Facilitate **production of evidence of env. damage** (e.g. reversal of burden of proof)

### OBGLIATIONS TO ENSURE ACCESS TO JUSTICE

- Execute and enforce judicial & administrative decisions in a timely manner
- **Redress** (e.g. restoration, compensation, financial penalty, assistance for affected persons)
- Minimize or eliminate barriers to access to justice
- Publicize access to justice right & procedures
- Systematize, disseminate judicial & administrative decisions
- Interpretation or translation of languages other than the official languages

## ENVIRONMENTAL DEFENDERS

Article 9

#### PROTECTING ENVIRONMENTAL DEFENDERS

- A safe and enabling environment so they can act free from threat, restriction & insecurity
- Recognize, protect & promote their rights (e.g. right to life, personal integrity, freedom of opinion & expression, peaceful assembly & association, free movement, access rights)
- Prevent, investigate and punish attacks, threats or intimidations



#### SPECIAL MEASURES: - PERSONS & GROUPS IN VULNERABLE SITUATIONS - INDIGENOUS PEOPLE

- Consider social, economic, cultural, geographical & gender characteristics of communities
- Offer technical & financial assistance
- Use language of people directly affected
- Use best media & formats
- Observe national & international standards for indigenous people
