












WHY CREATE A WATER AND OPEN GOVERNMENT DECLARATION?


To define global priorities on open government commitments on water service delivery and measure progress based on commitments that will have impact.

AREAS THE DECLARATION WILL COVER

TRANSPARENCY: Commitments to share data on water access and quality, setting tariffs, level of service, distribution and recovering cost or investment plans;

■ PARTICIPATION: Commitments to integrate participatory and equitable approaches to decision-making, budgeting and contracts and citizen monitoring using technology to accelerate response

■ GENDER AND SOCIAL INCLUSION:

Commitments to create access to clean, affordable water for all; addressing reasons for inequitable water quality and sanitation; focusing on water stressed and marginalized communities, with a focus on empowering people with disabilities, indigenous peoples, women, the poor and other vulnerable groups; and

■ ACCOUNTABILITY: Commitments to improve compliance mechanisms.



CREATION OF A FLOOR NOT A CEILING








- Workshops on the elements and ideas for the Declaration


RESULTS OF SURVEY
